



“Live Baby Live!”

“Baby Savers, a fantastic lifesaving initiative led by Trafford Community Leisure Trust in partnership with Manchester United & launched by Phil Neville is rolling out across Trafford.

The new ‘Baby Savers’ course is targeted at parents, grandparents and other members of the community, with an aim to provide these people with the essential tools that will enable them to save a baby if the unthinkable should occur.

The course was officially launched by footballer Phil Neville at Partington Leisure Centre on the 29th of April. Phil Neville said that, “This is a great initiative that will benefit everyone throughout Trafford. I am delighted to give this scheme my full support”

The two-hour courses, which are to be held across the Trust’s facilities, covers aspects of what to do if a baby stops breathing, has no signs of life, is choking or has drowned. The sessions will be led by fully qualified trainers and involve practical sessions.

The Trust has vast experience delivering a variety of courses including; water safety, lifesaving, health and safety at work and first aid at work. Bernie Jones Chief Executive from the Trust adds, “Baby Savers is the first course that the Trust has set up from scratch. With support from Manchester United we can feasibly offer a quality lifesaving course that is available to all residents in

Trafford. We have to remember that as with all lifesaving and first aid courses a little knowledge isn't dangerous it can save a life!"

In such a short time since the launch the Trust has already been inundated with bookings for the courses. The Trust and Manchester United are offering the Baby Savers course's free of charge.
